Students will need a piano or keyboard on which to practice at home.



Requirements:

- Your child's keyboard MUST have at least 61 keys (a full length piano has 88 keys)
- Music holder
- Bench (far preferred) or sturdy, flat-seated kitchen chair of an appropriate height
- Keyboard X-stand
- Real pianos must be tuned





The keyboard, music holder, bench and keyboard X-stand often come in a bundle.

Price: Quality 61-key keyboards range from \$50-\$150 new and used.

Where to buy: Look on Facebook Marketplace, Amazon.com, Walmart, Costco, Craigslist, Goodwill/Salvation Army, Ebay! *If you are having trouble finding a good deal or need assistance knowing whether or not a certain keyboard will be a good purchase, please don't hesitate to contact me!* If you'd like me to let you know when I come across a good deal, just ask!

Notes: You do NOT need to bring your keyboard to class.

Your child will use their keyboard for both 2nd and 3rd LPM years. After your child has graduated from LPM, you are welcome to sell your keyboard or keep it if your graduate will be going on to private lessons (or if you'll have another LPM student in the future)!
